

As part of Manor Children's Plan your child will receive worldwide dental injury and dental emergency cover (Denplan Supplementary Insurance) which provides

- ✓ Temporary emergency dental treatment in the UK (up to £450 per incident. Maximum amount payable £900 per calendar year)
- ✓ Temporary emergency dental treatment when overseas (up to £470 per incident. Maximum amount payable £940 per calendar year)
- ✓ Up to £62 for each night your child stays in hospital under the care of a dental or maxillofacial surgeon for dental treatment for up to one year
- ✓ Up to £12,000 towards one course of mouth cancer treatment for up to 18 months following diagnosis

#### Denplan Supplementary Insurance does not cover

- ✗ Emergency dental treatment provided by your child's dentist or a dentist/specialist acting on your child's dentist's behalf
- ✗ Dental injury caused whilst training for or participating in contact sports, unless appropriate mouth protection is worn
- ✗ Mouth cancer diagnosed before joining Denplan or within 90 days after the date your child joined Denplan (or for which tests or consultations began within those 90 days)
- ✗ Mouth cancer situated in the tonsils

### Childrens Plan 1 (5-10 years)

Please note that children (under the age of 5 years) of adult plan members will be seen free of charge for six monthly examinations and advice but will not be covered by Denplan Supplementary Insurance.

Treatment not covered by this plan can be paid for separately.

## How do you enrol your child onto our Children's Plan?

Following an initial examination the dentist will discuss with you the benefits of joining the Children's Plan. Joining is simple. All you have to do is complete a registration form and Direct Debit mandate on behalf of your child.

In addition to your first monthly payment, an initial registration fee will be charged and will be included in your first Direct Debit payment.

If you choose to cancel your child's plan for any reason you can do so by simply giving us one month's notice.
